Revelation 2:1-7

I. FIRST LOVE: A _____ HUSBAND

(Revelation 2:4) But I have this against you, that you have abandoned the love you had at first. (Isaiah 54:5) For your Maker is your husband, the Lord of hosts is his name; and the Holy One of Israel is your Redeemer, the God of the whole earth he is called. (Isaiah 62:5b) As the bridegroom rejoices over the bride, so shall your God rejoice over you.

II. FIRST LOVE: A _____ BRIDE

(Revelation 2:4) But I have this against you, that you have abandoned the love you had at first.

(Revelation 2:5) Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent, and do the works you did at first. If not, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place, unless you repent.
