Psalm 22:6-18; 27:27-44

I. EYES TO SEE JESUS: THE _____

(Matthew 27:28-30) And they stripped him and put a scarlet robe on him, and twisting together a crown of thorns, they put it on his head and put a reed in his right hand. And kneeling before him, they mocked him, saying, "Hail, King of the Jews!" And they spit on him and took the reed and struck him on the head.

II. EYES TO SEE JESUS: THE _____

(Matthew 27:39-40a) And those who passed by derided him, wagging their heads and saying, "You who would destroy the temple and rebuild it in three days, save yourself!" (John 2:21) But he was speaking about the temple of his body.

III. EYES TO SEE JESUS: THE _____

(Matthew 27:40b-43) "If you are the Son of God, come down from the cross." So also the chief priests, with the scribes and elders, mocked him, saying, "He saved others; he cannot save himself. He is the King of Israel; let him come down now from the cross, and we will believe in him. He trusts in God; let God deliver him now, if he desires him. For he said, 'I am the Son of God.'"
