## HABITS OF GRACE: PRAYER

Matthew 6:5-13; Psalm 27:4; Romans 8:15, 26-27

### I. PRAYER: \_\_\_\_\_

(Matthew 6:6) But when you pray, go into your room and shut the door and pray to your Father who is in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you. (Luke 11:1b) "Lord, teach us to pray..."

### II. PRAYER: \_\_\_\_\_

(Ephesians 1:17) "I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better..." (Psalm 27:4) "One thing I ask of the LORD...to gaze upon the beauty of the LORD and to inquire in his temple."  
(Matthew 6:12) "Forgives us our debts, as we have also forgiven our debtors."

### III. PRAYER: \_\_\_\_\_

(Matthew 6:9) "Our Father..." (Romans 8:15) For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!" (Romans 8:26) Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words.
