Matthew 25:18-19, Galatians 3:28, Revelation 7:9-10, 5:9-10

I. HEAL US EMMANUEL: THE NECESSITY OF _____

(Proverbs 28:13) Whoever conceals his transgressions will not prosper, but he who confesses and forsakes them will obtain mercy. (Isaiah 1:15-16) When you spread out your hands, I will hide my eyes from you; even though you make many prayers, I will not listen; your hands are full of blood. Wash yourselves; make yourselves clean; remove the evil of your deeds from before my eyes; cease to do evil.

II. HEAL US EMMANUEL: THE PRIORITY OF _____

(Zechariah 7:9-10) Thus says the Lord of hosts, "Render true judgments, show kindness and mercy to one another, do not oppress the widow, the fatherless, the sojourner, or the poor, and let none of you devise evil against another in your heart." (Proverbs 14:31) Whoever oppresses a poor man insults his Maker. (Proverbs 19:17) Whoever is generous to the poor lends to the Lord, and he will repay him for his deed.

III. HEAL US EMMANUEL: THE PREEMINENCE OF _____

(Galatians 5:6) For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision counts for anything, but only faith working through love. (2 Corinthians 5:18-20) All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself and gave us the ministry of reconciliation; that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation. Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ.
